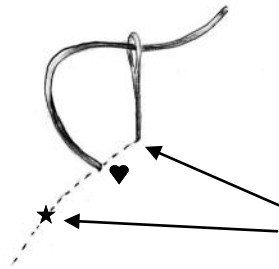


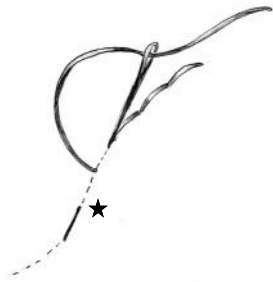
Hand Embroidery Stitches



Outline/Back Stitch

Bring thread to front of piece about $\frac{1}{8}$ " from beginning of line. ♥

Put needle into the fabric at the beginning of the line and re-emerge about $\frac{1}{8}$ " ahead of first thread. Pull thread through to complete first stitch.



Take the needle to the back by putting it into the same hole as the beginning of the last stitch. ♥

Re-emerge about $\frac{1}{8}$ " farther down the line. Continue the process until marking has been stitched.

Blanket Stitch



Bring thread to front. ♥

Put needle to the back ★ and re-emerge at applique' edge; position thread under needle.

Pull through until thread fits against edge without distorting it. Continue to work in evenly spaced stitches.

A corner has three stitches made in the same spot.
